સમિતિની બેઠક ગુરુવારે જિલ્લા કલેક્ટર ડો. વિકાંત પાંડેની અધ્યક્ષસ્થાને યોજાઈ હતી. અમદાવાદ કલેક્ટર કચેરી ખાતે મેળવી સમિતિની બેઠકમાં જમીનને લગતી વિવિધ ૩૧ જેટલી અરજીઓ હાથ પર લેવામાં આવી હતી. જેમાંથી ૧૧ કેસોમાં એફઆઈઆર દાખલ કરવામાં આવી છે. જ્યારે ૧૨ કેસો સિવિલ કોર્ટને તેમજ ૨ કેસ રિવિઝન માટે મોકલવામાં આવ્યા છે. સાથોસાથ ૬ કેસ સંબંધિત વિભાગ પાસે વધુ તપાસ માટે પેન્ડિંગ રાખવામાં આવ્યા છે. જિલ્લા કલેક્ટરે જિલ્લામાં જમીનને લગતા પ્રશ્નો પરત્વે કાળજી લેવા અને કોઈ લેભાગુ તત્ત્વો દ્વારા સાચા જમીન માલિકને અન્યાય ન થાય અને તેની જમીન પચાવી ન પાડે તે અંગે તકેદારીના પગલા લેવા માટે સંબંધિત અધિકારીઓને કડક સૂચના આપી કાર્યવાહી કરવા જણાવ્યું હતું અને જમીનને લગતા કેસોમાં સમીક્ષા કરી દર અઠવાડિયે કેસોનો નિકાલ કરવામાં આવશે તેમ તેમણે ઉમેર્યું હતું.

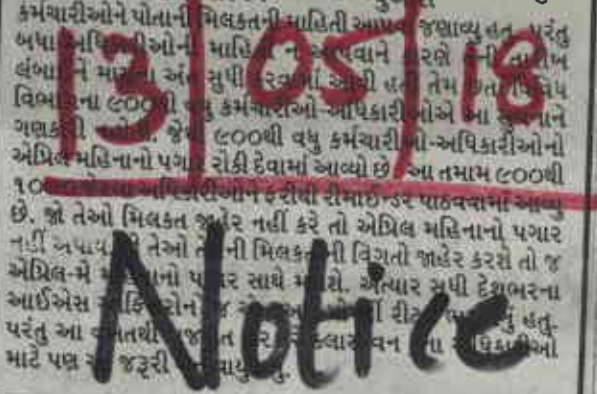

# probed over assault allegations

**Seoul,** The wife of the chairman of Korean Air will be questioned next week over allegations that she physically and verbally abused several employees of the company, an investigation official said on Monday.

Chairman Cho Yang-ho's wife Lee Myung-hee would be questioned on May 28 regarding claims that in 2014 she abused several workers at a hotel construction site in Incheon, located west of Seoul, Yonhap news agency reported.

Video footage emerged recently showing a woman, closely resembling Lee, pushing around a construction worker and throwing

documents at another.

The Korean Air chairman's younger daughter, Cho Hyun-min, was also called in for police questioning earlier in May for allegedly throwing a glass at an advertising agency official and injuring several other participants during a meeting.

Cho Hyun-min's elder sister, a former vice president of the group, Cho Hyun-ah, was sentenced to two years in prison for a notorious "nut rage" incident in 2014 during which she became enraged when a flight attendant served her macadamia nuts in a bag instead of on a dish. The plane was forced to return to the gate

at New York's John F. Kennedy Airport.

These incidents led to the Korean Air Chairman issuing a public apology and firing his daughters from the positions they were holding in the company.

The incident involving the Chairman's wife has once again reopened debate over the excessive power wielded by families who own huge South Korean conglomerates like Samsung and LG.

Cho Yang-ho is also suspected of having employed over 10 Filipino domestic workers illegally, Seoul's Immigration Office had reported earlier.

IOC creates refugee team for Tokyo 2020

Buenos Aires, The International Olympic Committee (IOC) has announced there will be an Olympic team made up of refugees at the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo, as happened in Rio de Janeiro in 2016.

"Last time (in the 2016 Rio Olympics) we were under very high time pressure. Now we have two years. We have already taken precaution...and we have a pool of athletes in place. Already now we're supporting 51 or 52 refugee athletes who we have identified. This pool can still grow in the run-up to Tokyo 2020," IOC president Thomas Bach of Germany said at the close of the 133rd IOC Session, which ended on Tuesday in Buenos Aires, Efe news reported.

The IOC said in a statement that with the creation of this refugee team, the committee seeks to convey a message of solidarity and hope to millions of refugee

and internally displaced athletes around the world.

"In an ideal world, we would not need to have a Refugee Team at the Olympic Games. But, unfortunately, the reasons why we first created a Refugee Olympic Team before the Olympic Games Rio 2016 continue to persist," Bach said, adding: "We will do our utmost to welcome refugee athletes and give them a home and a flag in the Olympic Village in Tokyo with all the Olympic athletes from 206 National Olympic Committees."

In the 2016 Rio Olympics, the team comprised ten refugee athletes from Ethiopia, South Sudan, Syria and the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

The 32nd Summer Olympic Games will take place from July 24 to August 9 in Tokyo.

Pro Kabaddi: Telugu Titans hand Tamil Thalaivas second straight defeat

Taiwan to hold referendum to change contingent name in Olympics

Taipei, Taiwanese will vote in a referendum to decide if the country's athletes should participate in the Tokyo 2020

Olympics and other international competitions under the name Taiwan, instead of Chinese Taipei, the Central Election Committee announced on Tuesday.

The referendum, which will be held on November 24 simultaneously with local elections, was approved after it received nearly half a million signatures in support, surpassing the minimum 281,745 that were required to greenlight it, re-

ports Efe. The petition for the name change for the 2020 Tokyo Olympics was led by Chi Cheng, a track and field athlete and a bronze medal-winner in the 1968 Olympics.

Owing to Beijing's insistence on the "One China" principle, Taiwan has been forced to compete in international sporting events under the name Chinese Taipei.

China had condemned the proposal of the name change as a pro-independence step, although the petitioners say they only want athletes to participate under the established name

of their island.

During the referendum, people will be asked if they agreed the country should participate in the upcoming Tokyo Olympics and other international sporting events under the name Taiwan.

The Sports Administration and the Chinese Taipei Olympic Committee (CTOC) have said they will respect the result of the referendum, although the International Olympic Committee (IOC) had said in a letter in May that the name of the contingent was already agreed upon in 1981 and remained applicable.

AFI targets Olympic success

Patiala, The Athletics Federation of India (AFI) has articulated its strong resolve to upgrade the training programme for its athletes to help raise the profile of the country's track and field sport from an Asian giant to one that will realise the long-standing dream of Olympic medals.

"It is time to follow up the good work of 2018 and recalibrate our goals and aspirations. We cannot be satisfied with the good showing at the Asian level and must get the breakthrough medals at the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo," AFI President Adille Sumariwalla said at the two-day AFI Coaches Orientation Programme at the Netaji Subash National Institute of Sports here.

"We are pleased with the readiness with which coaches bought in to the idea that we must now move from a force at the continental level to making a mark at the world level, with specific focus on the 2020 Olympics," he added.

After winning 19 medals, including seven gold, in the Asian Games on the back of team-work with Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Sports Authority of India, coaches, athletes and support staff, AFI has identified a set of athletes which will train with their coaches at different overseas locations. These athletes will also

compete in international meets so that they can secure rankings integral to the qualification process for the IAAF World Athletics Championships 2019 in Doha and the Olympic Games. AFI helped the coaches understand the new qualification process that the International Association of Athletics Federations has now introduced.

AFI also indicated that its quest for Olympic medals will not take away the focus from those athletes, especially the juniors, who have the potential to help India retain its place among Asia's best track and field nations.

"We will continue to work on the assembly line so that we have ample depth and width of events," the AFI chief said.

Ahead of the national camps across the country, the AFI strongly reiterated its no-needles policy for athletes and coaches. It also announced tighter anti-doping measures, including searching athletes and coaches' rooms and bags.

The AFI also reiterated that the Indian relay teams will be picked only from those who are selected to attend the national camps.

"We have identified a strong pool of men and women runners. We believe that with the right training and approach, Indian squads can be in medal con-

attention. We know there is ample room for improvement in the effort put in by the relay squads," the AFI President said.

## We make 'rasgullas' out of grotesque political occurrences: Painter A. Ramchandran

**New Delhi,** Veteran painter and Padma Bhushan recipient A. Ramchandran, who departed from the 'political' in art on belief that artists make "rasgullas" out of "grotesque" political events, is exhibiting a painting series at the Triveni Kala Sangam here, starting Tuesday. Organised by Vadehra Art Gallery, the solo show displays a series of drawings and paintings -- "The Changing Mood of the Lotus Pond" -- by the noted painter, whose rich artistic oeuvre started when his anger flowed out on his canvases. "When I started, my early works were highly political. My anger was pouring into my works; It was a natural tendency. Now, from an angry young man, I went to (being) a happy old man. I started questioning the political paintings and am totally convinced that political paintings are only journalism," the 84-year-old told IANS. Kerala-born Ramchandran, who has painted human suffering

and grim historic occurrences like the Nazi concentration camp and World War atrocities, recalled the 1984 anti-Sikh riots that had an indelible impact on him. "I saw it from my (east Delhi house) rooftop. There were 20 people chasing a 'sardarji' and killing him. That gave me such a terrible reaction. "These events are so grotesque; We make 'rasgullas' out of them. Painting is ultimately a beautiful object. Because it has certain qualities of beauty, that is why we recognise it as a work of art, otherwise it will only be a chair or a table," he opined. "Van Gogh's 'Sunflowers' is far greater than Pablo Picasso's 'Guernica' (a painting on war tragedies), because it has no message. The lack of message itself is a quality of a great work of art." By 1980s, the veteran artist had shifted his artistic focus to temple murals in Kerala and village life. Capturing the various moods and appearances of

a lotus pond, his 7-part painting series took birth in the hinterland around Rajasthan's Udaipur. As per Ramchandran, art also causes varied reactions for people. "When I first exhibited this series in Jehangir Art Gallery, there was a huge lotus pond painting. A young, married couple came and asked if they could take their marriage photograph against it. I told them to go ahead," he said. "I won't give an intellectual talk about lotus being an ancient motif; I don't talk all this nonsense. I leave it for people to look at it, and enter into it. When they enter into it, I have written so many essays explaining my point of view. "That is for those people, who are academically interested to understand my work. Those who don't want to, can casually look at it. If you get one or two minutes of happiness, I'm happy. If you don't, well, too bad for me." The exhibition will be open for public viewing till December 2. Entry is free.

## SC to hear Sonia, Rahul's plea in tax case

**New Delhi,** The Supreme Court on Tuesday agreed to hear appeals by Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi along with party leader Oscar Fernandes challenging a Delhi High Court order directing re-opening of their income tax assessment for 2011-12 related to the National Herald case. A bench of Justice A.K. Sikri and Justice Abdul Nazeer fixed December 4 as the final date of hearing. Justice Sikri said there were two options: issue notice and allow the assessing officer to proceed with the re-opening or fix the matter after some weeks and decide it. The court did not formally issue notice to the income tax authorities as Solicitor General Tushar Mehta

said he was present in court. Senior counsel P. Chidambaram, appearing for Sonia Gandhi, said during the pendency of matter, the re-assessment ordered by the Delhi High Court would not be given effect. To which, Justice Sikri said: "Now it will not." The Solicitor General said: "There is a difficulty, it may be time barred." Justice Sikri said in that case, the apex court stays the High Court judgement and that would take care of issue of the time bar. However, no stay order was passed by the court. Though there is no formal stay of re-assessment by the tax authorities, Solicitor General Mehta said the assessing officer may or may not proceed in terms of the High Court order.

## MHRD rolls out schemes for higher education teachers' training

**New Delhi,** The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) on Tuesday launched two training programmes for teachers in the realm of higher education, aimed to keep them updated on the latest developments in the world and to inculcate in them administrative skills to run their institutes. Leadership for Academicians Programme (LEAP) and Annual Refresher Programme in Teaching (ARPT) were launched here by Junior HRD Minister Satya Pal Singh. LEAP will be a three-week training programme (including one week training abroad) to train a sec-

ond-tier of academics likely to take up the reins of the institute in future. Its implementation will be done through 15 National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) ranked institutions, which include IIT Kanpur and Roorkee, Jawaharlal Nehru University, Delhi University, TISS Mumbai, and Banaras Hindu University. Among the foreign universities are Harvard University, University of Pennsylvania, LSE and Oxford, the ministry said in a statement. "There are good academics, who are not good in administration... most students who come take admission scoring above 90 per cent. They will do good

even without teachers. So what's the accountability of teachers? How are they adding value to the students' lives. I would request academics to enrol for the course," HRD Minister Prakash Javadekar said in a video message at the launch. For ARPT, a refresher training will be given to 15 lakh faculty members in higher education through the Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) using government platform SWAYAM. The government has identified 75 discipline-specific institutes, which it has named National Resource Centres (NRCs), to prepare training material. -- IANS

## India to be \$10 trillion economy by 2035: Suresh Prabhu

**New Delhi,** Union Minister for Commerce and Industry Suresh Prabhu on Wednesday said Indian economy will quadruple to \$10 trillion by 2035 riding on business-friendly policies, structural reforms and transparency in governance. "India is growing at a fast rate and will be a \$5 trillion economy in another 7-8 years. By 2035, it will be a \$10 trillion economy and we are preparing for that in an aggressive way," he said in a recorded message at the inauguration of India International Trade Fair (IITF). Prabhu said that no country can grow unless companies grow and their growth is dependent on inter-operations with rest of the world and the business-friendly policies of the government that saw India climb from 142 to 77 rank on Ease of Doing Business in last four years. "India is constantly improving and we want to take it beyond 50 and later even higher. India's ranking globally is increasing due to domestic policies. We are making structural reforms, we are bringing in transpar-

ency. We deal with complete transparency in public procurement." The Minister said IITF is India's flagship event where participants from across the globe take part. The 38th IITF, being organised in less than one-fourth of the area at Pragati Maidan due to ongoing renovation and construction, has 17 countries participating in it. "I am sure this will showcase India's capabilities... This is an event where businesses meet, policy makers meet to exchange ideas, to shape together a good future for humanity and to make world a better place by increasing your top lines and bottom lines and that can only happen when governments allow businesses to grow," he said. The partner country for the 14-day trade fair is Afghanistan, focus country is Nepal and focus state is Jharkhand. The theme of the international fair, with about 800 participants, is "rural enterprises" and was inaugurated by Minister of State for Commerce and Industry C.R. Chaudhary along with Union Culture Minister Mahesh Sharma.

While Sharma said the country is fortunate to have an enterprising Prime Minister, Chaudhary said foreign investment worth more than \$60 billion comes to India each year under the Make in India scheme launched by the PM and that India is set to become a manufacturing hub. Jharkhand's Khadi Gram Udyog Board Chairman Sanjay Seth said the tribal state, which will turn 18 years old on November 15, has been growing at over 10 per cent under the current leadership of Raghubar Das with major progress in basic infrastructure like roads. India Trade Promotion Organisation officials said while the current fair is organised in only 22 per cent of the total space due to construction activities, the next IITF will be the biggest ever as a world class international exhibition cum convention centre will be ready by then. -- IANS

## Bharti Airtel tanks over 4% after Moody's downgrade

**Mumbai,** Shares of telecom major Bharti Airtel Ltd slipped over 4 per cent on Tuesday after ratings agency Moody's downgraded some notes of the company by the subscribers.

After falling up to 4.33 per cent in early trade, the company's stock recovered to trade at Rs 306.20 per share, down 0.13 per cent during the afternoon session on the BSE.

Moody's Investor Service on Tuesday downgraded the senior unsecured rating for Airtel and backed senior unsecured notes issued by subsidiary Bharti Airtel Int'l (the Netherlands) to 'Ba1', or junk rating, from 'Baa3'.

The American rating agency also withdrew the company's 'Baa3' issuer rating and said the outlook was negative.

"The downgrade reflects uncertainty as to

whether or not the company's profitability, cash flow situation and debt levels can improve sustainably and materially, given the competitive dynamics in the Indian telecom market," Moody's Vice-President Annalisa DiChiara said in a note.

"A significant recovery in cash flow from the core Indian mobile segment is needed to strengthen the company's credit quality and support greater financial flexibility," DiChiara said.

Moody's, at the same time, assigned a Ba1 corporate family rating (CFR) to Airtel, saying it reflects the company's solid market position in the high growth Indian mobile market.

"We recognise the company has raised \$1.45 billion from the pre-IPO of its African operations, with around \$1 billion used to repay debt on consolidated basis," the ratings agency said.

"The rating outlook could be stabilised if Bharti strengthens its credit profile, with stabilisation of its core Indian mobile and non-mobile services," it added.

Moody's estimated that the profitability of Bharti's Indian mobile segment will remain low over the next several quarters in the absence of a fundamental change in the pricing of mobile services, together with proportional shift in the composition of Bharti's subscriber base to high-end 4G customers.

Bharti Airtel last week said its net income for the October-December quarter declined nearly 72 per cent to Rs 86 crore due to continuing pricing pressure.

The company has, however, taken steps to improve revenues and profitability including its minimum recharge plans, the Moody's report added.

## Samsung Galaxy M20: Decent hardware, bigger screen in a budget

**New Delhi,** South Korean major Samsung was dethroned by Chinese smartphone player Xiaomi in India in 2018 - the same way Samsung stole the limelight from Nokia in 2012.

Xiaomi dominated 2018 with a market share of 28 per cent while Samsung grabbed 24 per cent share in the same period, according to Counterpoint Research.

Samsung has been feeling the pinch in the affordable and budget segment and now, to counter the growing competition from its Chinese counterpart, the company has introduced "Galaxy M" series that marks a strategy shift in terms of design language, chipset upgrade and internals.

Marketed as "India-first" smartphones, the newly-launched Galaxy M20 and Galaxy M10 are an attempt to offer better specifications at an affordable price.

The Galaxy M10 costs Rs 7,990 for the 2GB RAM+16GB storage variant while the Galaxy M20 will come for Rs 10,990 (3GB RAM+32GB storage version).

IANs used M20 for almost a week and here is what we think of it.

The Galaxy M20 is a step

forward in terms of design language, courtesy the "Infinity-V" notch screen that houses a selfie sensor in it.

The 6.3-inch screen on the phone has an aspect ratio of 19.5:9 with well-rounded corners. The tiny notch sure renders a tall display real estate.

The rear side consists of polycarbonate panel which definitely didn't feel as sturdy and premium as those with glass backs.

The device supports a futuristic Type-C charging port sandwiched between a 3.5mm headphone jack and a speaker grille, which a good addition considering the price point.

## Rs 50,000 cr at stake; Sebi clampdown coming on MFs lending against shares to promoters

**New Delhi,** Alarmed by the recent Zee episode in which nine mutual funds (MFs) were found to have lent a staggering Rs 7,000 crore to promoters of Zee group and then found themselves unable to liquidate the security of listed shares for fear of being unable to recover their full amounts, SEBI is preparing to bring new regulations that will expressly prohibit MFs

from entering into such transactions, according to sources. Not just that, the market regulator is planning to direct MFs to convert all existing innovative security structures into direct pledge of shares, to give at least some measure of control to the MFs. Of late, with the use of fancy footwork by promoters and MFs alike, there has been a spate of similar transactions with NDUs (non disposal under-

takings), non-encumbrance undertakings and covenants limiting transfer of shares, but all falling short of pledging the shares. Considering how illusory the security of pledged shares have proven in the Zee episode, Sebi feels all other fancy structures obviously provide no safety at all investors, and these need to be all converted into direct pledge of shares immediately.

## Monaco's tech companies can tie up with India: President

**New Delhi,** Monaco's technology and investment companies can significantly benefit from the Indian growth story, President Ram Nath Kovind said on Tuesday, when Prince Albert II of Monaco called on him at the Rashtrapati Bhavan.

Welcoming Prince Albert to India, the President said India and Monaco had always enjoyed a relationship of trust, friendship and mutually beneficial cooperation. The current visit imparts a strong impetus towards taking the relationship to newer heights. The President said that India-Monaco ties were doing well but there was scope to do a lot more together.

On issues such as renewable energy, climate change and the environment, there was a strong meeting of minds between the two countries, the President said. "We must prioritize these areas for bilateral cooperation."

## Slack confidentially files to go public: Report

**San Francisco,** Work collaboration tool Slack has announced it is ready to go public without disclosing much details of its listing plans, making it one of the first major Initial Public Offerings (IPO) of 2019.

Slack, the messaging and chat application for businesses, appears to be setting itself up for the \$3.5 trillion health-care market. CNBC reported late on Monday. The company, which confidentially filed to go public, has also updated its security page to note that it is Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) compliant, thus, suggesting that it is working toward a use case where health-care providers can begin using it to share sensitive patient health information.

The firm indicated via Twitter that only the enterprise version of the product which is Slack Enterprise Grid is HIPAA compliant without commenting further.

Slack has "submitted a draft registration statement on Form S-1" to the US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), with the public listing due to take place after the SEC completes its review process. A direct listing means Slack will forego the support of traditional underwriters and will give insiders the option to sell instantly. That often results in volatility in the company's early trading days, according to Fortune. Founded in 2009, Slack is essentially a collaboration hub for work. It emerged from the ruins of a failed game company called Tiny Speck which shut down in 2012.
